MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES COMMITTEE OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOWBROOK HELD ON MONDAY, MAY 11, 2015 IN THE WILLOWBROOK POLICE STATION, 7760 QUINCY STREET, IN THE VILLAGE OF WILLOWBROOK, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

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1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Mistele called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. ROLL CALL

Those present at roll call were Chairman Michael Mistele, Trustee Suzanne Berglund, Assistant to the Village Administrator Garrett Hummel, and Village Resident Blaine Panitch. Absent: Village Administrator Tim Halik.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- a) After review of the draft minutes from the April 13, 2015 Regular Meeting of the Municipal Services Committee, Chairman Mistele made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Trustee Berglund seconded the motion. Motion carried.

4. VISITOR'S BUSINESS – Village resident Blaine M. Panitch regarding the Village's use of Chemical Herbicides in Park Properties

Trustee Mistele welcomed Mr. Panitch to the meeting and asked him to present his information. Mr. Panitch began by referencing his letter (included in the agenda packet) dated 04/13/2015. Mr. Panitch feels the Village contracts for too many applications of herbicide throughout the year. The particular applications that Mr. Panitch does not feel are necessary are the middle of the summer (July) application because he feels the grass has gone dormant and the late fall/winter application because again the grass has gone dormant and the chemicals are simply washed away by the winter snowfall. Mr. Panitch stated that while walking his dog past Village parks, they are exposed to a variety of chemicals due to the Village's application of herbicide. Mr. Panitch cited several articles which he brought to the meeting highlighting various dangers of using/being exposed to lawn care chemicals. Trustee Mistele acknowledged Mr. Panitch's concerns and said the Village would look into reducing the number of applications made by the Village's contractor TruGreen. Mr. Panitch inquired as to whether there was anything the Village could do with respect to restricting homeowners from applying lawn care chemicals. Trustee Mistele stated the Village would not be able to forbid residents from having lawn care chemicals put on their property. Trustee Berglund suggested adding informational material to the Village's website that could inform residents as to any dangers associated with the application of lawn care products. Trustee Mistele thanked Mr. Panitch for coming to the meeting and presenting his concerns.

5. DISCUSSION – HVAC Maintenance Contract Proposals

Assistant to the Village Administrator Hummel advised the Village's agreement with Season Comfort Corp for heating and air conditioning (HVAC) maintenance service has expired. Season Comfort has installed many of the HVAC units currently serving the Village Hall and staff is satisfied with their response time on calls and the quality of their work. However, their fees have increased over time. Upon acquiring the new buildings at 825 and 835 Midway Drive, staff learned that the buildings were under HVAC agreements with The Heat Engineering Company out of Countryside. The former owners of the buildings were very

satisfied with the maintenance services provided and advised that their annual fee was by far the lowest offered by similar contractors. Staff reached out to The Heat Engineering Company for a proposal for HVAC services at all four Village buildings (Village Hall, Police, Public Works, and Community Resource Center). The Heat Engineering Company provided a proposal in the amount of \$4,030 per year which includes preventative maintenance service inspections twice a year, and filter changes three times per year. The Heat Engineering Company also provided a 10% discount on repair parts. Staff recommends the Village accept the proposal from The Heat Engineering Company for HVAC maintenance services. A resolution accepting the proposal would be placed on the agenda for the May 26, 2015 regular meeting of the Village Board. The Committee agreed with the staff recommendation.

6. REPORT – Municipal Services Department

- a. Assistant to the Village Administrator Hummel reviewed the monthly permit activity report for the month of April 2015. The Village has taken in just over \$20,000 in permit revenue for the month of April. Hummel advised that in total for the fiscal year 2014/15, the Village has received approximately 202.73% of the anticipated FY2014/15 budgeted revenue.
- b. Assistant to the Village Administrator Hummel shared the water system pumpage report for March 2015. The report indicates that the Village pumped 28,779,000 gallons in the month of March. Hummel shared that we have pumped about 9% less water this year as compared to the same timeframe last year. Hummel also advised that at eleven months into the fiscal year, we are below where we should be in order to meet our estimated pumpage projection of 385,000,000 gallons – we are off by about 62,000,000 gallons with one month remaining.

Motion to adjourn was made by Chairman Mistele and seconded by Trustee Berglund. The meeting was adjourned at 6:25 PM.




## Village of Willowbrook June 2015 - Status Report

### Season Perspective

Weather conditions critically affect the seasonal mosquito population. Excessive rainfall periods trigger hatches of floodwater mosquitoes (*Aedes vexans*), the dominant annoyance species in northern Illinois that has a flight range of 15 to 20 miles. The other target species is the northern house mosquito (*Culex pipiens*), the primary vector of West Nile virus (WNV) that flourishes under stagnant water drought conditions.

As of June 21<sup>st</sup>, the Illinois State Climatologist, Dr. Jim Angel, reported that June of 2015 is the wettest June on record for Illinois. The remnants of *Tropical Storm Bill* impacted a large portion of Illinois during the third week of June. The following Illinois State Water Survey map shows that many areas of the state received over 10.0 inches of rain during June:





Most of the Chicagoland area received at least 6.0 inches during June. The National Weather Service expects wetter than average conditions to continue for July. The flooding rains and saturated soil conditions have set the stage for a much above normal season for the floodwater mosquito. As a result, larval control efforts in floodwater areas have been intensified, and the extreme mosquito annoyance periods will require frequent adult mosquito applications, timed to hit floodwater mosquito migration brood peaks.

Average June rainfall at O'Hare International Airport is 3.45 inches. Through June 26<sup>th</sup>, 6.17 inches was officially recorded. Since May 1<sup>st</sup>, there have been a series of nine (9) significant rainfalls and associated floodwater mosquito hatches. However, the impact of the some of these projected floodwater broods was diminished because an inconsistent temperature pattern. The first part of July is forecasted to be rainy with cool temperatures. This cooler pattern will continue to diminish the impact of floodwater mosquito brood influxes.

### **Mosquito-Borne Disease Update**

As of June 23, 2015, a total of 15 states have reported West Nile virus infections in people, birds, or mosquitoes in 2015. Overall, five cases of West Nile virus disease in people have been reported to CDC in KS, NM, OK and TX. Of these, two (40%) were classified as neuroinvasive disease (such as meningitis or encephalitis) and three (60%) were classified as non-neuroinvasive disease.

On May 29<sup>th</sup>, the Illinois Department of Public Health reported the first WNV-positive adult mosquito sample in downstate St. Clair County, across from St. Louis. WNV activity is anticipated to increase in July with the return of summerlike temperatures. On June 12<sup>th</sup>, the DuPage County Health Department reported a WNV-positive adult mosquito sample in the northeast corner of the county.

### **Recommendations**

The CDC currently shows a risk category 1. Biting adult mosquitoes activity and limited or sporadic epizootic activity in birds or mosquitoes. Conduct Integrated Vector Management program to monitor and reduce vector mosquito abundance. Conduct environmental surveillance to monitor virus activity (mosquitoes, sentinel chickens, avian mortality, etc.) Initiate community outreach and public education programs focused on personal protection and residential source reduction.

### **Village of Willowbrook May 2015 - Status Report**

#### **Season Perspective**

Weather conditions critically affect the seasonal mosquito population. Excessive rainfall periods trigger hatches of floodwater mosquitoes (*Aedes vexans*), the dominant annoyance species in northern Illinois that has a flight range of 15 to 20 miles. The other target species is the northern house mosquito (*Culex pipiens*), the primary vector of West Nile virus (WNV) that flourishes under stagnant water drought conditions.

The National Weather Service (NWS) U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook map shows the soil moisture level in northern Illinois has been restored to a “normal condition,” and the Illinois State Climatologist reports that no part of Illinois is in drought now. Replenished soil moisture sets the stage for an above average season for the floodwater mosquito.

According to the NWS Climatic Prediction Center, an El Niño weather pattern has been established across the United States. There is a 90% chance of the pattern staying this summer, and an 80% chance of remaining through the end of 2015. In terms of strength, this El Niño is expected to be weak to moderate. Illinois is expected to have an increased chance of cooler-than-average conditions in the late summer on into fall.

May rainfall at O’Hare International Airport was 2.1 inches above normal; 5.84 inches was recorded versus the normal amount of 3.74. There was a series of four (4) significant rainfalls and associated floodwater mosquito hatches. However, the impact of the projected floodwater broods was diminished because an inconsistent temperature pattern. For the first part of June, Chicagoland temperatures are forecasted to be near normal. This will increase the impact of floodwater mosquito broods that emerge in the first half of June.

#### **Mosquito-Borne Disease Update**

In 2014, a total of 47 states and the District of Columbia have reported WNV infections in people, birds, or mosquitoes. Overall, 2,122 cases of West Nile virus disease in people have been reported to CDC, including 85 fatalities. Of these, 1,283 (60%) were classified as neuroinvasive disease (such as meningitis or encephalitis) and 839 (40%) were classified as non-neuroinvasive disease.

So far in 2015, there has only been one (1) human case reported in the United States in Houston, Texas. California has already reported 49 WNV-positive birds and 40 positive mosquito samples. On May 29<sup>th</sup>, the Illinois Department of Public Health reported the first positive mosquito sample in downstate St. Clair County, across from St. Louis. WNV activity is anticipated to increase in June with the return of summerlike temperatures.
