

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE SPECIAL MEETING HELD ON JANUARY 26, 2010 AT THE VILLAGE HALL, 7760 QUINCY STREET, WILLOWBROOK, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Baker called the meeting to order at the hour of 8:00 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Those present at roll call were Chairman Dennis Baker, Trustee Paul Schoenbeck, Acting Village Administrator Larry Maholland, Acting Chief Mark Shelton, Director of Finance Sue Stanish, and Deputy Chief Pat Foley.

3. REVIEW WILLOWBROOK POLICE DEPARTMENT 2010-11 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET

Acting Chief Shelton reviewed the Willowbrook Police Department's 2010-11 fiscal budget. The Committee discussed the DuMeg contribution and decided not to contribute this year due to the lack of activity generated in Willowbrook. In the event the department needs assistance, the department has access to our DEA Task Force and the DuPage County Sheriff's Office.

The Committee reviewed the Willowbrook Cadet Program and recommended to continue the program. A donation of \$4,000.00 will be kept in this fiscal budget.

The Committee reviewed the Willowbrook Bike Program. Due to budgetary costs, it was recommended to suspend the program for one (1) year.

Trustee Schoenbeck suggested that the Committee consider changing the payment process for special details. He asked that the bills be paid in advance, so that the village does not have a loss of funds due to non-payment. Acting Chief Shelton advised that there has only been one business that the village has had a problem with and it has been resolved. The only time the department collects funds prior to the date of the actual event, is when it is a "large" event (i.e. Kerry Piper St. Patrick's Day, etc.).

The Committee agreed to cut all other items that were cut from the budget.

4. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 a.m.
