- *The Committee was advised that the Tornado Siren was activated by Southwest Central Dispatch and worked effectively. The testing of the siren will be conducted the first Tuesday of every month.*
- *The Committee was advised that new squad #57 is in service and is being used by the Officers.*
- *The Committee was advised that the Southwest Central Dispatch contract was ratified by their members and will be going before the Board of Directors on June 22nd, 2011.*
- *The Committee was advised that the Bullet Proof Vest Grant has been completed and we may receive \$1,887.00 from June 2009 Grant remainder and \$1,540.00 for the 2011 Grant. The Grant pays 50% of our total cost.*
- *The Committee was advised that the Department received \$5,200.00 from a State Police / Willowbrook P.D. narcotics arrest/seizure and also the use of a vehicle. However, it was explained that the vehicle, if not used, must be returned to I.S.P.*
- *The Committee was advised that Chief Shelton had received an e-mail from Trustee Baker advising that he had read and approved the Agenda and Meeting Minutes.*
