8. DISCUSSION ITEMS
 - Accreditation
The Committee was advised that the \$3,200 Accreditation reimbursement has been received from IRMA and that the Willowbrook Police Department was awarded re-accreditation with excellence by the entire Commission while in Mobile, Alabama.
 - Squad Car Purchase
The Committee discussed and agreed to the purchase of a new canine vehicle utilizing State Drug Forfeiture funds. The existing canine vehicle will be re-assigned as the new squad #58. This will replace the existing squad #58, the 2006 Dodge Charger, which has had numerous issues resulting in escalating maintenance costs.

The Committee discussed the training which will be conducted at the Westmont Police Department, on April 19th and April 26th, with other law enforcement agencies. These agencies will all be working together during this training.
