

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOWBROOK HELD ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 21, 2011, AT THE VILLAGE HALL, 7760 QUINCY STREET, WILLOWBROOK, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at the hour of 7:00 a.m. by Chairman William Schuler.

2. ROLL CALL

Chief Shelton reviewed the Final Eligibility List for Police Officer with the Board. There were sixty-seven (67) candidates that qualified for the list, which will be in effect until January 21, 2013.
