I want to tell you how helpful and patient Office Svehla is.






We have received a request from a resident to install a new stop sign at the above referenced location (also see map below). According to the complainant, drivers are attempting to avoid traffic at the intersection of Plainfield & Madison and are cutting through the Waterford Subdivision. When this occurs, drivers traveling on eastbound Ridgemoor Drive make a right-turn onto Rodgers Drive without stopping. Apparently this has caused conflicts for southbound drivers on Rodgers Drive.

I believe this is a reasonable request and am slightly surprised that there is not a stop sign or yield sign there already. I thought perhaps an existing sign had been hit and removed, but not replaced. However, when I checked the ordinance (8-3-3:A) the location is not listed as a stop street (it is also not listed under 8-3-6:A as a yield street). Therefore, I believe a stop sign is warranted. The process would be to present a staff recommendation at the next Public Safety meeting on August 13th. With the Committee's authorization, we can then place an ordinance on the Board's agenda for either 8/13 or 8/27 for their consideration.

In accordance with Section 8-2-11, the Police Chief has the authority to authorize the installation of the stop sign as a temporary measure (to address the safety concern) for not more than 90 days. This would then give us time to work through the formal process to amend the ordinance to include this intersection as a stop street.

Please advise whether you concur with the above. If so, I'll ask public works to install the new stop sign ASAP.
