I. PURPOSE

This directive:

- A. establishes procedures to facilitate the initial identification of any incident where the City of Chicago or the Department has incurred expenses and has an opportunity to recover its cost relative to personnel and equipment use or damaged property.
- B. continues the Cost Recovery Incident Form ([CPD-61.230](#)).

II. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. Chapter 1 - 20 of the Municipal Code of Chicago (MCC) authorizes the City to seek financial compensation (including the recovery of court costs and attorney fees) for the wages and benefits of City personnel, the reasonable costs of equipment and materials, and any other costs allocable to the provision of services that are the result of any person's violation of any federal, state, or local law.
- B. Examples of potential cost recovery incidents include, but are not limited to:

1. the deployment of police to respond and provide service as a result of a person's false reporting of a crime, e.g., false bomb and fire reports.

2. major police-service levels from specialized units, e.g., SWAT deployment for hostage, barricaded, or terrorist incidents.

3. violation of any law or ordinance, even if the offense was committed before, during or after a civil demonstration or protest.

4. events resulting in the delivery of lengthy traffic control services due to fires, hazardous materials, motor vehicle crashes, trucks hitting viaducts, unsafe building conditions, and other similar events due to a possible law or ordinance violation.

NOTE: Department members will NOT submit the Cost Recovery Incident Form (CPD-61.230) for Department vehicle traffic crashes or any other incidents resulting in the City of Chicago to be listed in the Damaged Properties field of the Illinois Traffic Crash Report.

5. organized, but not legally sanctioned events (i.e., without permits), for which the Department must increase staffing levels or provide other than customary service.
6. quality of life offenses such as graffiti or damage to property.
7. court appearances when Department members are notified or subpoenaed to appear in court, as a result of cost recovery incidents.

8. incident(s)/event(s) resulting in the response of six or more City vehicles.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. Preliminary investigators, follow-up investigators, and supervisors will recommend events for cost recovery consideration such as personnel, equipment, or damaged property by:
1. completing a Cost Recovery Incident Form ([CPD-61.230](#)).
 2. attaching copies of the supporting documents (e.g., PCAD printout for event, Arrest Report, Case Report, or a To-From-Subject Report) to the member's station supervisor/designated unit supervisor describing the incident.
 3. tracking all court time resulting from this cost recovery incident.
 4. submitting the Cost Recovery Incident Form and supporting documents to the station supervisor/designated unit supervisor.
- B. Station Supervisors or designated unit supervisors will:
1. review and, if appropriate, approve all documents.
- NOTE: The reviewing supervisor will ensure the incident is NOT a Department vehicle traffic crash or any other incident resulting in the City of Chicago to be listed in the Damaged Properties field of the Illinois Traffic Crash Report.
2. forward the original cost recovery package to the Director, Finance Division.
 3. forward a copy of the cost recovery package to the unit commanding officer.
- C. Records Division will forward information from Department vehicle traffic crashes and any other incidents resulting in the City of Chicago to be listed in the Damaged Properties field of the Illinois Traffic Crash Report directly to the City of Chicago Department of Finance.
- D. The Director, Finance Division, will:
1. gather, coordinate, and solicit supplemental investigative reports and personnel assignments to complete the package.
 2. submit the completed package and relevant reports to the Department of Revenue or Law, as appropriate, in the manner and format identified by these departments.

Chapter 39 - RECOVERY OF COSTS

ARTICLE I. - EMERGENCY RESPONSE COST RECOVERY

Sec. 39-1. - Definitions.

The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Assessable costs means the reasonable costs incurred by the City of Aurora ("City"), or by a private person, corporation, or other assisting government agency, operating at the request or direction of the city, in connection with an emergency response and/or in connection with providing services. The term "assessable costs" includes, but is not limited to:

- (1) The labor, equipment, usage and material costs of providing police, fire, rescue, and emergency medical or other services at the scene of an emergency response and the costs incurred by other city departments in an emergency response. The costs include excavation, transportation and disposal of any materials.
- (2) All employee salaries, wages, workers' compensation benefits, overtime, fringe benefits, and administrative overhead of responding, supervising, investigating, reporting, and testifying of city personnel where such services are required by an emergency response, the investigation or an emergency response incident or any prosecution brought in connection with such an incident.
- (3) All salaries, wages, and compensation of responding, supervising, investigating, reporting, and testifying personnel of any assisting government agencies acting at the request or direction of the city where such services are required by an emergency response, the investigation or an emergency response incident or any prosecution brought in connection with such an incident.
- (4) All costs, expenses, and fees, including actual expert witness and attorney fees, incurred in connection with the prosecution of the responsible party.
- (5) The replacement cost of all disposable materials and supplies used in connection with an emergency response.
- (6) All rental or leasing costs incurred for equipment used in connection with an

emergency response, including the costs of any contracted labor.

- (7) The actual replacement cost of any equipment lost or rendered beyond reuse or repair during an emergency response.
- (8) The words "assessable costs" includes all costs of the city incurred in relation to the provision of services by the city or its agents, regardless of whether the city would have otherwise incurred those costs, including but not limited to wages and benefits of personnel involved in providing such services, reasonable costs of equipment used in the provision of such services, costs of materials expended in providing such services, costs of storing or disposing of hazardous or any other materials recovered during the course of providing such services, or any other costs allocable to the provision of services.
- (9) In any action brought under this chapter, the city shall also be entitled to recover a penalty in an amount equal to the city's litigation and collection costs and attorney's fees.

Emergency response means the providing, sending, and/or utilizing of police, fire fighting, and/or medical and rescue services by the city, or by a private entity, corporation, or other assisting government agency operating at the request or direction of the city, to an incident presently of serious and urgent threat to human life, public safety and welfare, real or personal property, including nuisance or aggravated nuisance response.

Responsible party means any person, firm, corporation, association, partnership, commercial entity, consortium, joint venture, government entity, or other legal entity whose actions or inactions causes or contributes to an occurrence resulting in an emergency response, or any owner, tenant, occupant or party in control of real or personal property from which, on which, or related to which there is an emergency response and the heirs, estates, successors, and assigns of such owners, tenants, occupants, or parties.

Specialized response resources means equipment, supplies, vehicles, and specially trained personnel that may be utilized to provide emergency response services or mitigation in connection with a specialized response.

(Ord. No. O07-128, § 1, 11-27-07; Ord. No. O08-99, § 1, 10-14-08)

Sec. 39-2. - Liability for city expenses.

(a)

Any owner, lessor, lessee, or operator of any property to which there is an emergency response shall be liable for the assessable costs relating to the emergency response.

- (b) Any registered owner, lessor, lessee, or operator of any motor vehicle, the operation of which results in an emergency response, shall be liable for the assessable costs relating to the emergency response.
- (c) Any person who is the subject of an emergency response shall be liable for the assessable costs relating to the emergency response.
- (d) Regardless of any other provision of this chapter or Code of Ordinances, any person causing a fire, an accident, or the release of any hazardous material giving rise to an emergency response shall be liable for the assessable costs relating to the emergency response.
- (e) Any public or private utility whose activities or facilities necessitated an emergency response shall be liable for the assessed costs of the emergency response.
- (f) When an emergency response directly benefits more than one (1) person or property, each person and/or property benefited shall be jointly and severally liable for the payment of the assessable costs relating to the emergency response. For purposes of any emergency response involving a motor vehicle, occupants other than the operator and the registered owner shall not be liable for the assessable costs relating to the emergency response. For purposes of any emergency response involving real property, occupants other than the owner, lessor, lessee and operator shall not be liable for the assessable costs relating to the emergency response.
- (g) Any person who causes the city or its agents to incur costs in order to provide services reasonably related to such person's violation of any federal, state or local law, or such person's failure to correct conditions which violate any federal, state or local law when such person was under a legal duty to do so, shall be liable to the city for those costs. This liability shall be collectible in the same manner as any other personal liability.
- (h) In any case in which a person is liable for costs pursuant to this chapter, and such liability arises as a result of that person's actions within the scope of his employment by any other person, such other person shall also be liable for such costs.

(i)

The city shall be entitled to recover any and all assessable costs relating to an emergency response from any or all responsible parties jointly or severally and assessable costs may be allocated among and between responsible parties, including allocating all or some assessable costs jointly and severally against more than one (1) responsible party.

- (k) In an action brought under subsection (g) of this chapter where the city has issued a written notice of a violation, it shall be a defense that the defendant undertook reasonable efforts to remedy the existing violation of law within the time prescribed in the city's notice or, if no time is prescribed in the city's notice, a reasonable period of time.

Sec. 39-3. - Billing and collection of assessable costs and late payment fees.

- (a) The director of the department providing emergency response services will submit an appropriately completed invoice request with a supporting itemized statement of expenses concerning the services provided to the city's director of finance or his designee. Said invoice request shall be submitted to the finance director within thirty (30) days of providing the services. Within thirty (30) days of receiving an invoice request, the director of finance or his designee may issue an invoice to any person liable for assessable costs of the emergency response services or, if known, the person's insurance company. Said payment related to said invoice shall be due within thirty (30) days.
- (b) Upon a determination to assess costs made pursuant to this chapter, the city's finance director shall submit an itemized invoice, by first class mail or personal service, to each responsible party. Invoices for assessable costs will be due and payable within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing. Thereafter a late payment fee equal to one (1) percent per month of the unpaid balance shall be assessed, added to the total unpaid balance, and collected in the same manner as assessable costs.
- (c)

If a responsible party appeals an assessment of costs, and that assessment is upheld in whole or in part, the costs upheld shall be due and payable within thirty (30) days from the date of determination of the appeal and late payment fees shall thereafter apply as provided in subsection (b) of this section.

- (d) The city may proceed by action in any court of competent jurisdiction to collect any assessable costs due and owing under the provisions of this chapter and it shall have all remedies provided by law in connection with the collection of same.
- (e) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to impair any cause of action or legal remedy.

Sec. 39-4. - Appeal of city finance director's decision to the city council.

- (a) Any responsible party who receives a statement of costs assessed pursuant to this chapter, or that person's insurance company, may appeal any or all of the amount shown on the statement by filing a written appeal with the city council through the city clerk's office within fourteen (14) calendar days of the date of the statement of assessed costs. The appeal must be accompanied by a written explanation as to all the reasons why the full amount on the statement should not be charged to the person and why the responsible party believes the costs assessed pursuant to this chapter should be modified. Any reason, basis or argument for a modification of the assessed costs not set forth in the written request to appeal shall be deemed waived by the responsible party. Failure to file a written appeal within fourteen (14) days of the date of the statement of assessed costs shall constitute a waiver of the responsible party's right to appeal and to appear before the city council.
- (b) Upon receipt of a request for city council review, the city clerk will place the appeal on the agenda of a regularly scheduled city council meeting that is at least twenty-one (21) calendar days after the date the responsible party's request for city council review is received.
- (c) At the city council meeting, the responsible party shall have the opportunity to address the city council regarding the written appeal and the request that the city council modify the assessed costs. The responsible party shall be limited, in addressing the city council, to those reasons and bases set forth in that responsible party's written appeal and have the burden of proving, by a preponderance of relevant facts, that the determination appealed from is

The failure to pay any debt due the city, including, but not limited to, amounts owed on account of a fee, lease, rent, service, sale of real or personal property, overpayment, administrative or judicial judgment, fine, penalty, restitution, damages, interest, tax, reimbursement, recovery of a cost incurred by the city or other source of indebtedness to the city, after the period granted for payment has expired by any person liable for such debt, shall constitute a violation of this chapter. Judgment shall be entered against any person who violates this chapter in the amount of the debt remaining unpaid on the date the judgment is entered plus litigation and collection costs, attorney's fees and an amount representing all fines and penalties assessed pursuant to this chapter. An administrative penalty of one (1) percent of the amount of debt remaining unpaid on the date the judgment is entered shall be assessed for each month or portion thereof in which the debt remained unpaid.

- a. In addition to any other means authorized by law, the city may enforce this chapter by instituting an action through its administrative adjudication system.
- b. Nothing in this chapter shall preclude the city from seeking to collect any debt due the city through the use of any other administrative procedure or court proceeding authorized by law.

(f) Any expenses collected pursuant to this chapter shall be supplemental to other methods of financing emergency response, including but not limited to budget appropriations, ad valorem taxation, grants, and other sources permitted by law.

(c) Nothing in this section shall preclude the city from seeking to collect any debt due the city through the use of any other administrative procedure or court proceeding authorized by law.

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DU-COMM FIRE FUNDING FORMULA RECOMMENDED CHANGES EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The member agencies have long taken pride in their role of self-governance of such a successful intergovernmental cooperative as DU-COMM. In over forty-four (44) years of existence, DU-COMM has successfully provided public safety communications for its member agencies.

A significant challenge the organization has faced, at a policy level, is that of equitable funding. While often debated over the years, the funding formula has been relatively unchanged in the forty-four (44) years. In 2017, a Subcommittee was established by the Board of Directors to examine concerns from a few member agencies specifically regarding the fire funding formula.

The Fire Funding Subcommittee met over two years and reviewed many options. The largest challenge was that any change would create significant winners (agencies with reduced annual costs) and losers (agencies with increased annual costs). The Subcommittee was comprised of agencies on polar opposite sides of the issue, which prevented a unanimous recommendation.

In January of 2019, the Subcommittee lacked consensus to bring the issue to a vote. Following that Board of Directors meeting, Manager Scott Niehaus came to the Executive Subcommittee and suggested another attempt be made with the Subcommittee to look for a consensus that addressed most agencies concerns. It was also noted that in an era of competition, inequalities, real or perceived, could lead to destabilizing an organization. Current member agencies, involved in the fire funding discussion, were also making inquiries about moving dispatch services to Addison Consolidated Dispatch Center (ACDC).

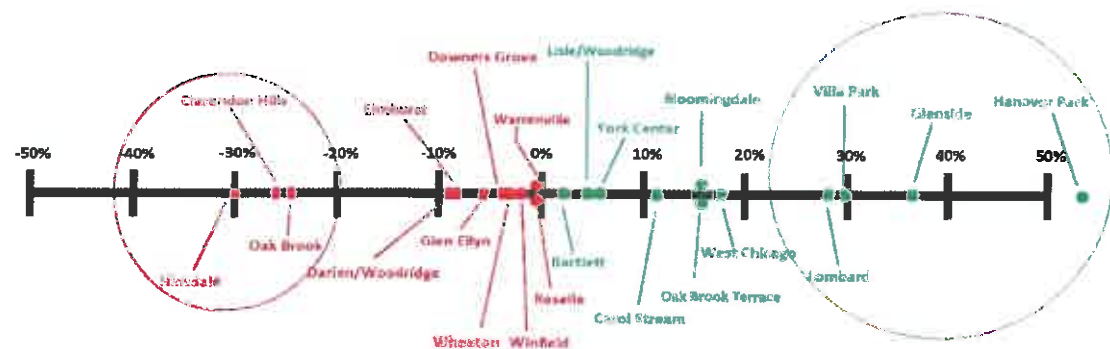
At the March Executive Subcommittee meeting, Mayor Martin Tully of Downers Grove challenged the Subcommittee to define the objectives of changing the formula. It was agreed that the primary objective was to maintain organizational integrity. With this new direction and the addition of two new members, the Fire Funding Subcommittee met again to look specifically at addressing the issues for the most impacted agencies (defined below). DU-COMM's current fire funding formula is based on 100% Equalized Assessed Valuation (EAV) or tax value of the jurisdiction to determine each agency's share of the DU-COMM fire budget.

The request of several agencies was to move away from EAV to a calls for service model, which would be determined by using only the calls for service, without auto or mutual aid,

within a jurisdiction. This calls for service formula change would significantly impact agencies with lower EAVs and higher call volumes.

Based on the large impact on using calls for service, the Subcommittee reviewed a compromise: a 50/50 split between EAV and calls for service. This hybrid approach still caused financial impact concerns for many agencies, as illustrated by the following diagram, which clearly shows how seven (7) agencies are impacted by at least 20% by moving from a 100% EAV formula to a 50/50 split model:



Recognizing this obstacle to reach a consensus, the Subcommittee looked “outside the box” to transition to the new formula, which was discussed at the final meeting where a vote of 5-0 occurred to recommend four changes to the fire funding formula:

- (1) Move from solely using EAV to a 50/50 EAV/calls for service formula over four (4) years for most agencies;
- (2) The three (3) agencies whose costs would be reduced by twenty percent (20%) or more would move to the new formula immediately in the next fiscal year. The financial impact to starting them immediately would be covered by agency reserves;
- (3) The four (4) communities with increased costs over twenty percent (20%) would transition to the new formula over more than four years. There would be a five percent (5%) cap above the increase in the fire budget to each agency per year. This would allow these agencies to transition to the new formula over a longer time. The impact of capping their increases would be covered using agency reserves, but these agencies would repay DU-COMM the deferred costs after a determined period of time; and
- (4) All formula components will be averaged over a five (5) year time period (smoothing) to minimize any impacts.¹

The attached bylaws’ revision incorporates these changes and will be presented to the Board of Directors for consideration at its October 2019 meeting, after review by the Executive Committee.

Whenever any Village officer or official is authorized to charge a person or arrest a person without a warrant for a violation of the law, the Village officer or official may, in lieu of filing a complaint in court, issue the alleged violator a notice of violation. These notices of violation carry a penalty of a fine only and are listed in the Willowbrook Municipal code Chapter 4: General Penalty. The fine structure dates back to 1996 and has not been amended to reflect current fine structures.

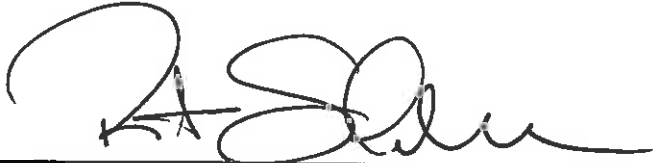
LETTER OF RECOGNITION

On Saturday September 14th, 2019 at approximately 8:26pm, Officers Silva, Vanderjack, and Porter responded to 6340 Americana Drive in reference to a "Man with a Gun" call. Upon arrival, responding officers located the subject and determined that he was in crisis. Officer Vanderjack immediately requested Tri-State FD for a psychological evaluation after speaking with the subject who had made suicidal statements. The officers subsequently located and removed two weapons from the subject's possession and secured them for safekeeping at the Willowbrook Police Department with the help of Detective Polfliet.

During the follow up conducted by Sergeant Strugala, a Firearms Restraining Order was obtained and a search warrant for additional weapons was secured. Execution of the search warrant by Detective Polfliet, Officer Chavez-Jimenez, and Officer Handzik resulted in addition ammunition and loaded magazines being recovered.

All of the officers involved should be recognized for their teamwork and attention to detail. Their diligence and hard work in seeing this case through until the end, lead to a successful crisis intervention.
