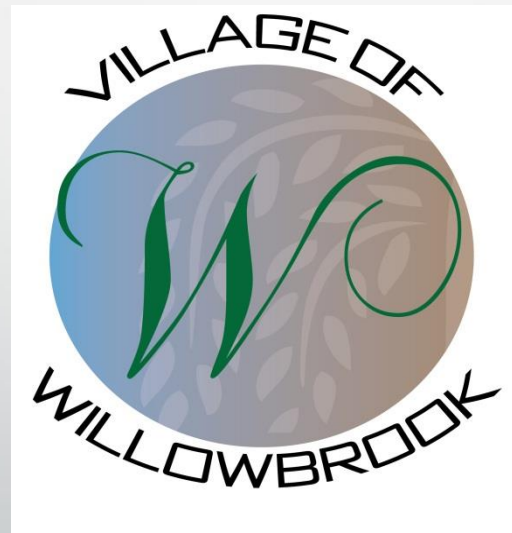

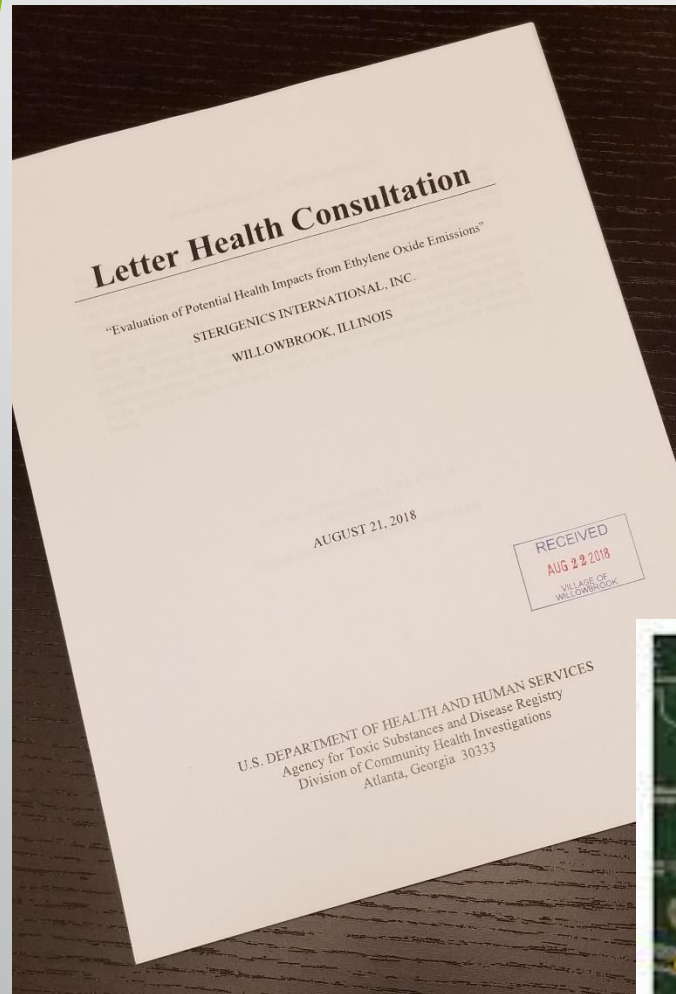

- ✓ **11/29/18** – USEPA holds public forum meeting
- ✓ **11/30/18** – Village joins lawsuit against Sterigenics
- ✓ **12/7/18** – USEPA begins posting its testing results
- ✓ **12/10/18** – Village posts its one-day testing results

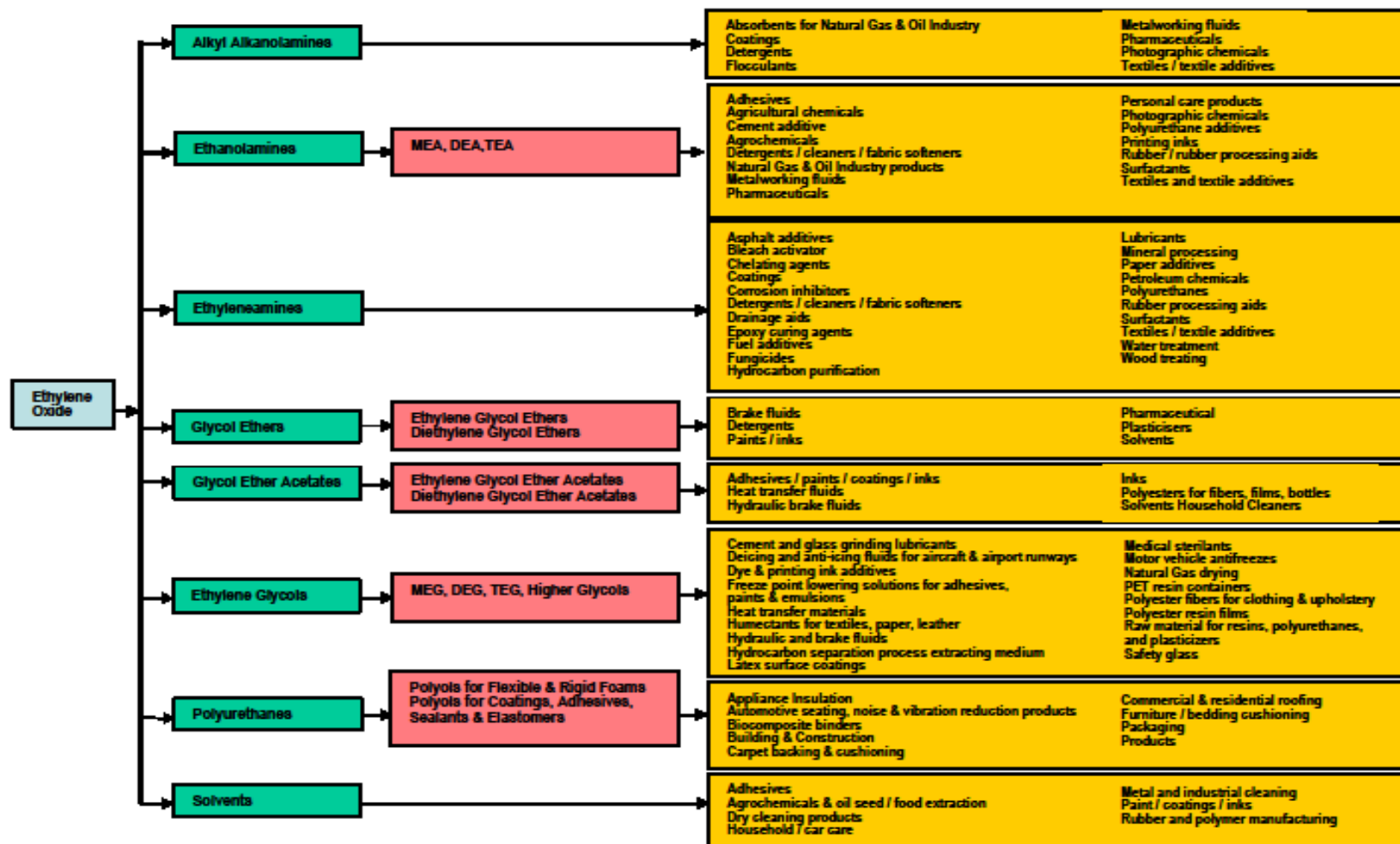

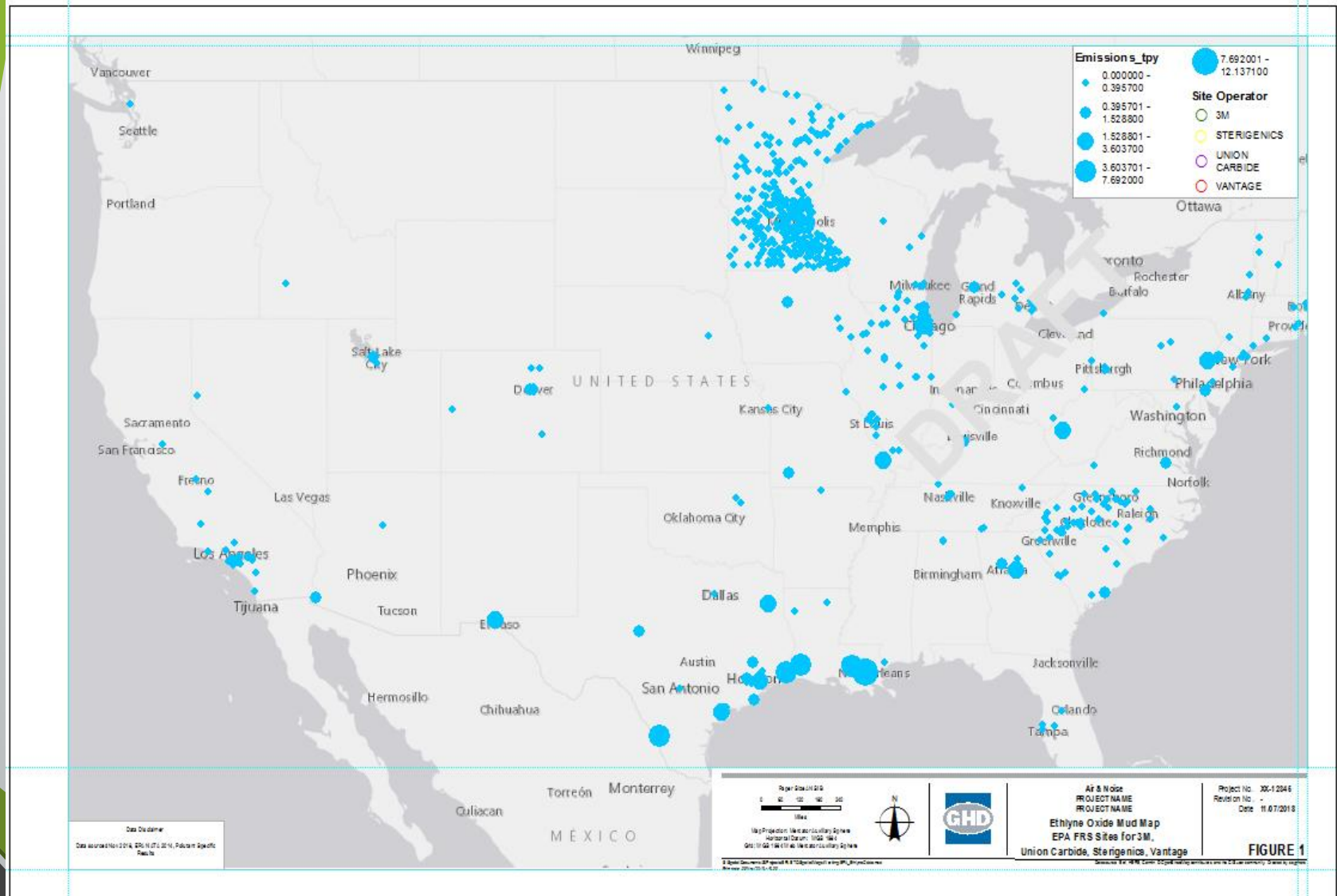
Uses of Ethylene Oxide

Ethylene Oxide - An Essential Raw Material For Many Important Products

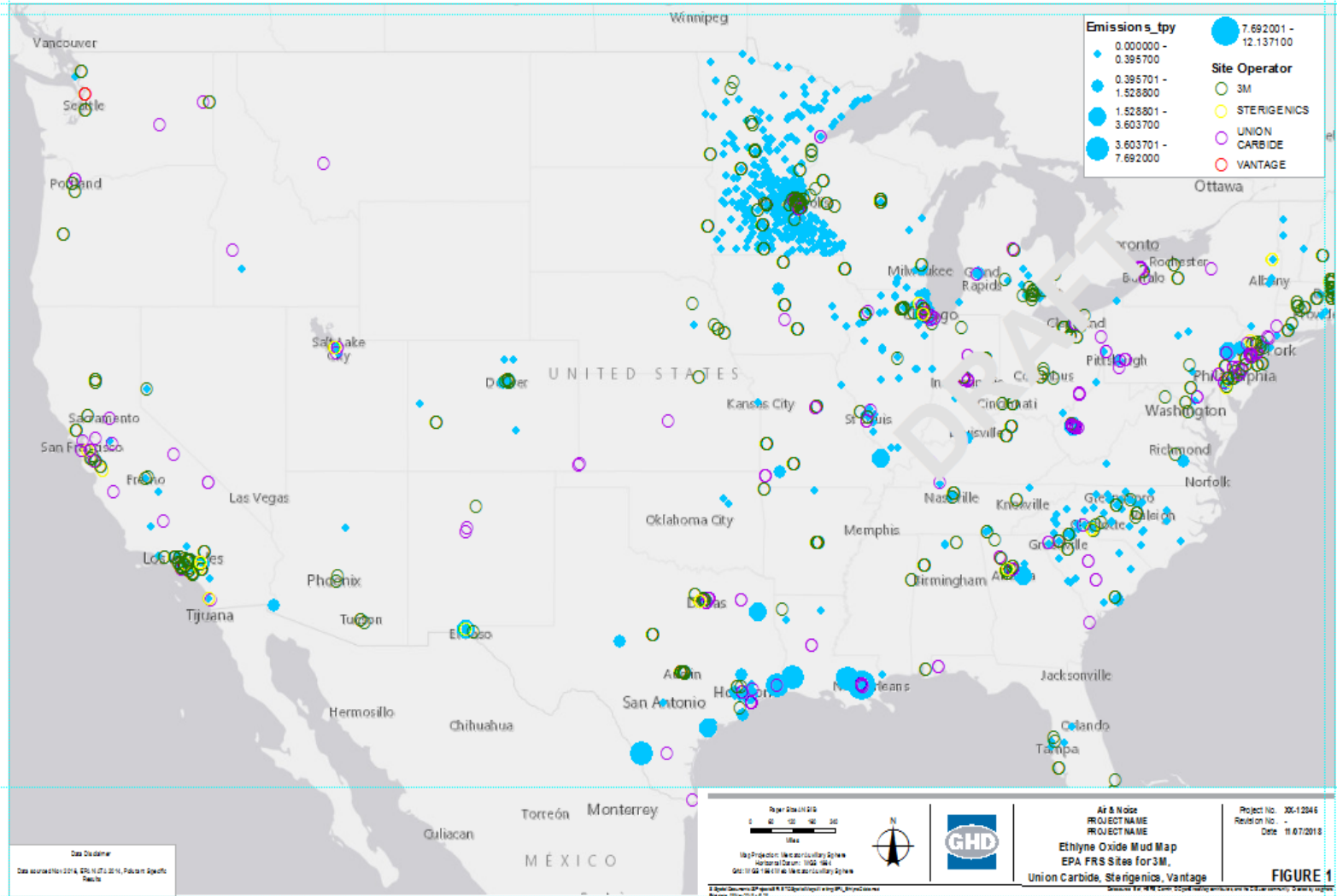

September 24, 2018

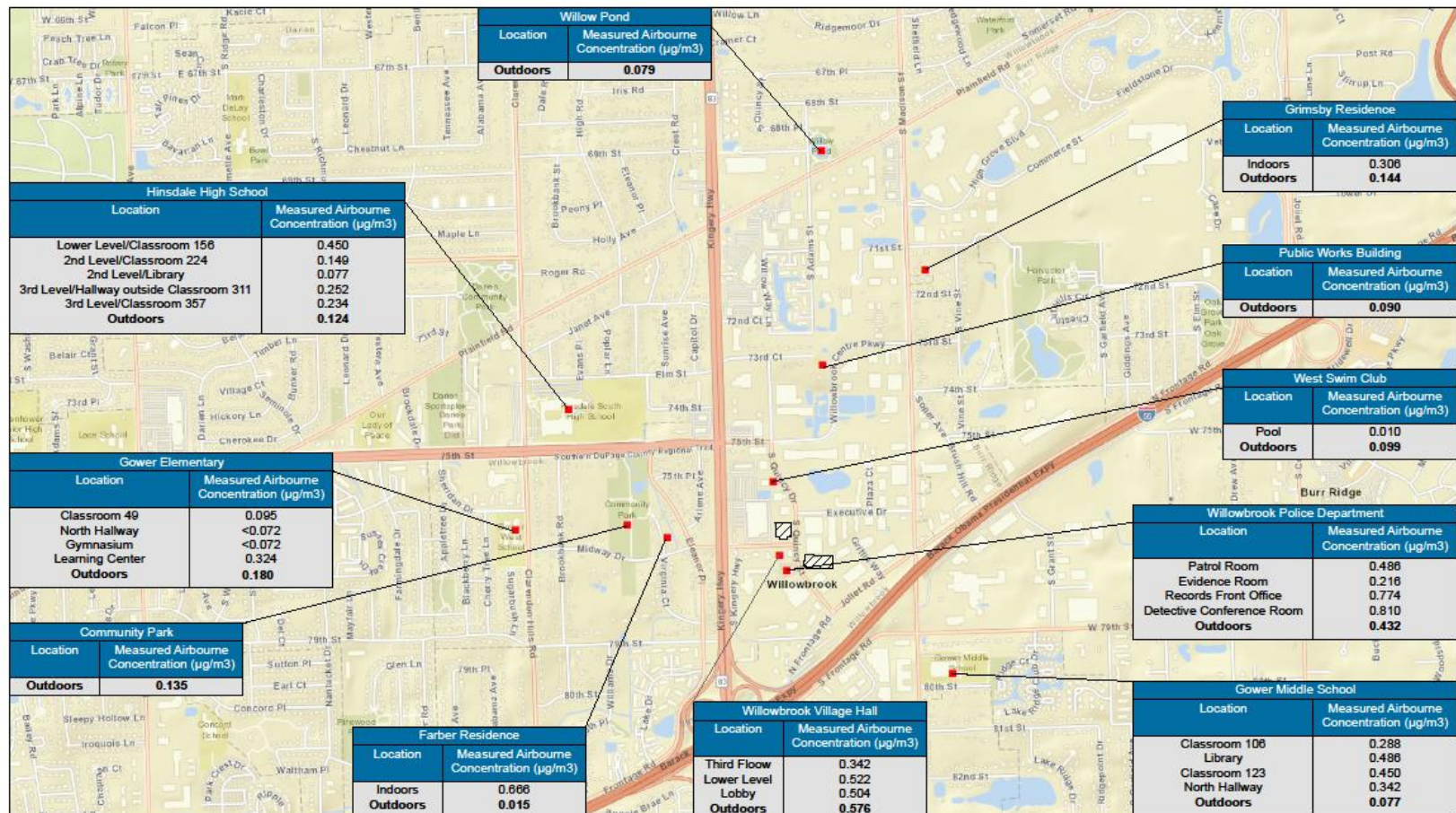
Willowbrook hires GHD Services, Inc. to perform indoor/outdoor ambient air testing. 34 samples at 11 locations taken on November 16th & 17th. (Burr Ridge also performs outside ambient air testing. 8 samples at 8 locations taken on November 13th & 14th.)

September 28, 2018

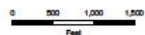
The USEPA commits to conducting further outdoor ambient air testing for a 3 month duration, which began in November. 8 locations in Willowbrook, Burr Ridge, Darien.

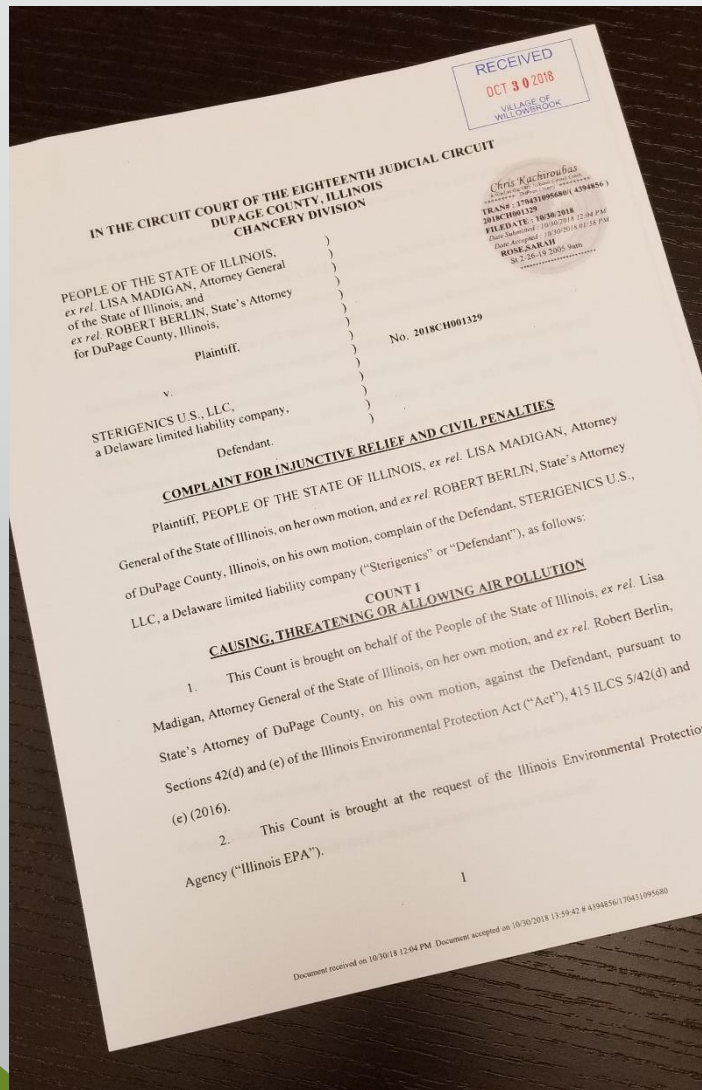
Sterigenics Environmental Issue – 2018

October 30, 2018

Lisa Madigan, Illinois Attorney General, and Robert Berlin, DuPage County State's Attorney, file a lawsuit against Sterigenics in Circuit Court urging the state court to either shut them down or enforce more stringent limits on EtO emissions. Attorneys for Sterigenics have since filed a Motion to remove the case to Federal Court. Willowbrook joined the lawsuit on November 30, 2018.

December 11, 2018

Due to disparity in tested levels, Mayor Trilla demands that the Illinois A.G. and DuPage County S.A take emergency action to cease operations at Sterigenics.

- ❑ \$941,117 PROJECT - \$400,000 OF WHICH WAS REIMBURSED THROUGH A STATE OSLAD GRANT
- ❑ NEW WATER SPLASHPAD, PLAYGROUND, PLAY PODS, PAVILION SHELTER, STONE FISHING OUTCROPS, PATHWAY LIGHTING, PERMANENT RESTROOMS, CONCRETE WALKWAYS

ROUTE 83 CORRIDOR STUDY

- ❑ **Purpose**: to enable the Willowbrook community to have input into the design of the state's eventual widening of Route 83 through town
- ❑ Original study was commissioned by the village in 1990
- ❑ In response to the 2015 Federal Transportation Bill, the F.A.S.T. Act, which provides \$305B in funding to improve the nation's freight transportation system through 2020.

Phase I – discovery w/ steering committee

Phase II – draft corridor plan w/outreach

Phase III – Final Plan adopted by the Village Board: August 27, 2018

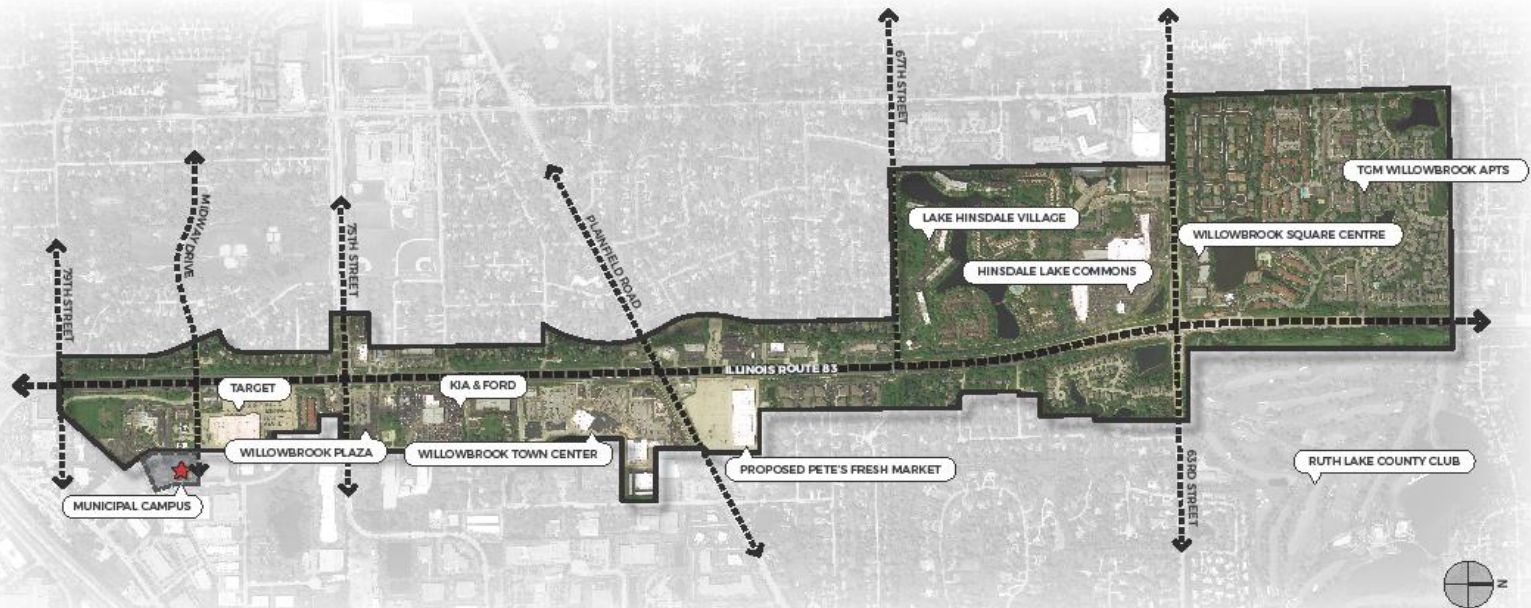

Exhibit "A": Proposed Study Area Boundary

Illinois Route 83 is the Village of Willowbrook's arterial roadway spine, as well as a significant regional corridor with approximately 44,000 to 47,000 vehicle trips per day within the Village of Willowbrook's municipal boundaries. The proposed study area limits for the proposed Illinois Route 83 Corridor Plan Update are identical to the study area limits as shown in the adopted 1991 plan. Since few or no annexations have occurred within proximity to the Illinois Route 83 right-of-way in the last twenty-six (26) years there is no reason to consider changing the corridor area study boundary. The study area as shown below begins at 79th Street on the south (just 0.22 miles north of the I-55 Expressway) to 59th Street on the north. The total north-south length of corridor within the study area is 2.52 miles or approximately 13,300 feet. The study area is narrow in its east-west breadth, as it includes only adjacent commercial and pertinent residential properties along the Route 83 corridor. Major developments within the proposed study area include, Target, Willowbrook Plaza Shopping Center, the Kia and Ford automobile dealerships, Willowbrook Town Center, the proposed Pete's Fresh Market redevelopment, Lake Hinsdale Village, Hinsdale Lake Commons including Whole Foods, Willowbrook Square Center, TGM Willowbrook Apartments, among others. Major crossroads include Midway Drive, 75th Street, Plainfield Road, 67th Street, and 63rd Street.



ComEd Powering Safe Communities Grant



- ❑ IN MARCH 2018, VILLAGE APPLIED FOR GRANT THROUGH THE METROPOLITAN MAYORS CAUCUS (MMC) AND COMED'S POWERING SAFE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM
- ❑ \$9,362 GRANT AWARDED
- ❑ REPLACED 12 STOP SIGNS WITH SOLAR POWERED LED SIGNS TO INCREASE VISIBILITY AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS

Economic Development Activity

The Pete's Fresh Market Development (former K-Mart Store Site)



- ❑ BOTH PETE'S FRESH MARKET AND STEIN MART OPENED FOR BUSINESS ON NOVEMBER 1, 2018. ULTA OPENED ON NOVEMBER 7TH.
- ❑ ANCHOR TENANTS INCLUDE: PFM, STEIN MART, ULTA. OUTLOT BUILDING TENANTS INCLUDE: AT&T, LUMES PANCAKE HOUSE RESTAURANT, PINK NAILS, FIREHOUSE SUBS, FAMILY DENTAL.
- ❑ TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS ON PLAINFIELD ROAD ARE SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETE, REMAINDER OF ROUTE 83 IMPROVEMENTS AND PERMANENT TRAFFIC SIGNALS WILL BE COMPLETED BY SPRING 2019

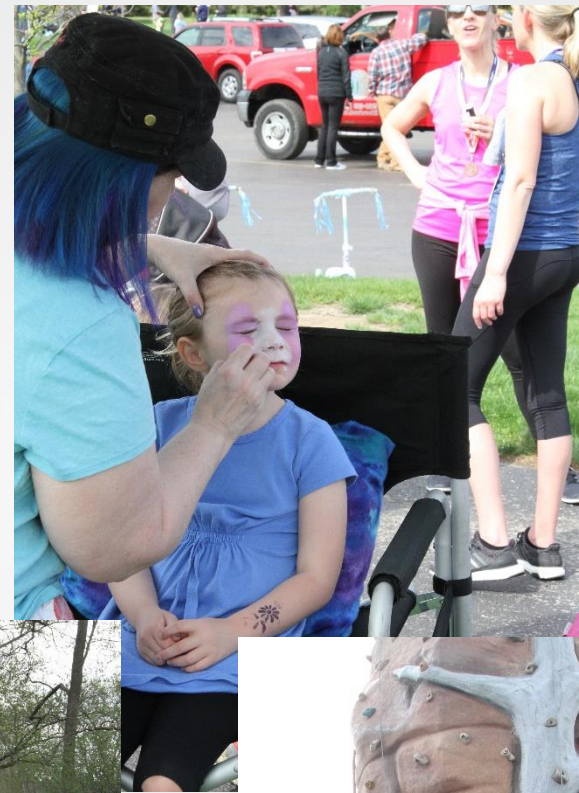

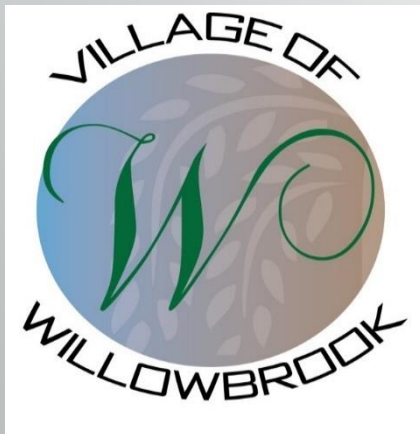
