Decommissioning Update #7 for Sterigenics Sterigenics locations: 7775 Quincy Street

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What is being done? The Village of Willowbrook is in the process of issuing an “Partial Exterior Demolition & Building Restoration” Permit to Sterigenics at 7775 S. Quincy Street. This is a continuation of the decommissioning of the facility.

Who requested this? The Property Owner & the tenant, Sterigenics. This is one of the final stages of the decommissioning of this building, and part of their lease agreement with building ownership.

Why is this being done? Sterigenics does not ‘own’ the property. The Property Owner requires the tenant to return the building to the condition at time of original lease.

What will be involved? Crews will be onsite to dismantle all the exterior modifications Sterigenics has made to the building shell, including the tall portions of the building.

What equipment will be involved? Typical construction equipment consisting of heavy machinery movers, refuse dumpsters, work trucks, forklifts, construction personnel, etc. During this process, refuse dumpsters will be located on the property, as well as within the building’s interior dock bays.

When will this process begin? Immediately upon Permit Approval & Issuance.

How long will the process take: Likely through July 2020.

What is the next step? The Village will post another update when those details become available.

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
